### A BILL

To prohibit COVID-19 liability waiver enforceability for large indoor gatherings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

This Act may be cited as the "Refusal to Accept Losses or Liability In Every Situation Act" or "RALLIES Act".

## SEC. 2. COVID-19 LIABILITY WAIVERS UNENFORCEABLE FOR LARGE INDOOR GATHERINGS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Title 9 of the United States Code is amended by adding at the end the following:

#### "CHAPTER 4—WAIVER OF LIABILITY DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

### "§ 401. COVID-19 liability waiver unenforceable for large indoor gatherings

Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, no agreement entered into waiving liability pertaining to contracting COVID-19 at an indoor gathering of more than 1,000 persons shall be valid or enforceable for an event occurring in a locality experiencing a 14-day increase in the number of COVID-19 cases.
