This project is an appropriate use of federal funds because it will support reconfiguration and reconstruction of a critical intersection, identified on the City of Madison's High Injury Network, to allow for safe bicycle and pedestrian crossings to the Capital City Path and Monona Lakeshore in Madison. The project will utilize funds to include a new traffic signal with new safe pedestrian and bicycle crossings, increasing safety and neighborhood connectivity to the Capital City Path, Monona Lakeshore, and adjacent parklands. Funds will also support reconstruction of the intersection's stormwater runoff infrastructure to reduce flooding and property damage.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
