I am requesting funding for the Mt. Horeb, WI Rural Health & Employment Services Facility Construction project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is:

Madison Area Rehabilitation Centers (MARC), Inc.

The funding would support the construction of a new facility to provide essential health and employment services for adults with developmental disabilities in a rural community. The new facility will double the individuals with disabilities receiving care, reduce the number of individuals waiting for services, create direct support jobs boosting the local economy, and enable more people with disabilities to receive job coaching supports in the community. This project is an appropriate use of federal funds because this new building would serve as an essential public health resource for individuals with disabilities in and around Mt Horeb, a rural community with extremely limited access to healthcare, job support, and social services. MARC is one of the only Medicaid providers in the Village of Mt Horeb and surrounding rural counties serving adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a).
