I am requesting funding for the Kegonsa Sanitary District Force Main Relocation project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is:

The funding would be used to relocate critical force main sections along Highway 51 and install two metering manholes between Stoughton, WI and McFarland, WI.
